It is with great satisfaction that I inform you that every month we have more therapies and more families who attend the Centre. We also have a beautiful sensory garden, altruistically designed by our patron Elena Guembe Fesser. Many of its trees and games are donations. The boccia court is being used by different entities and brings much liveliness. Furthermore, throughout the year there were several stays of parents with their disabled children. They were all been delighted by the Centre! In Madrid we obtained two fantastic, specially-adapted electric bicycles with trailers thanks to various fundraising initiatives and a collaboration with the Asociación SonÁngeles.

Without a doubt another highlight of 2015 was the presentation of our "Construction and Equipment of Children's Inclusive Playgrounds Manual", which is the result of the work of many people. We hope that it will be helpful to other entities that are interested in building a park where children with different abilities can play, too. We also launched a members' club, thanks to which we have managed to double income by instalments in one year. The new tax deductibles, which are much more attractive, have also helped us. I encourage you to become a member of this beautiful and necessary project.

On behalf of the beneficiaries, as well as the team and patrons of Lukas Foundation, I would like to thank all the people and institutions who allow us to enthusiastically move forward with projects that improve the daily lives of people with different abilities.

In 2015 we began to provide therapies and are progressively increasing the number of sessions and users, as well as the number of available therapies.












